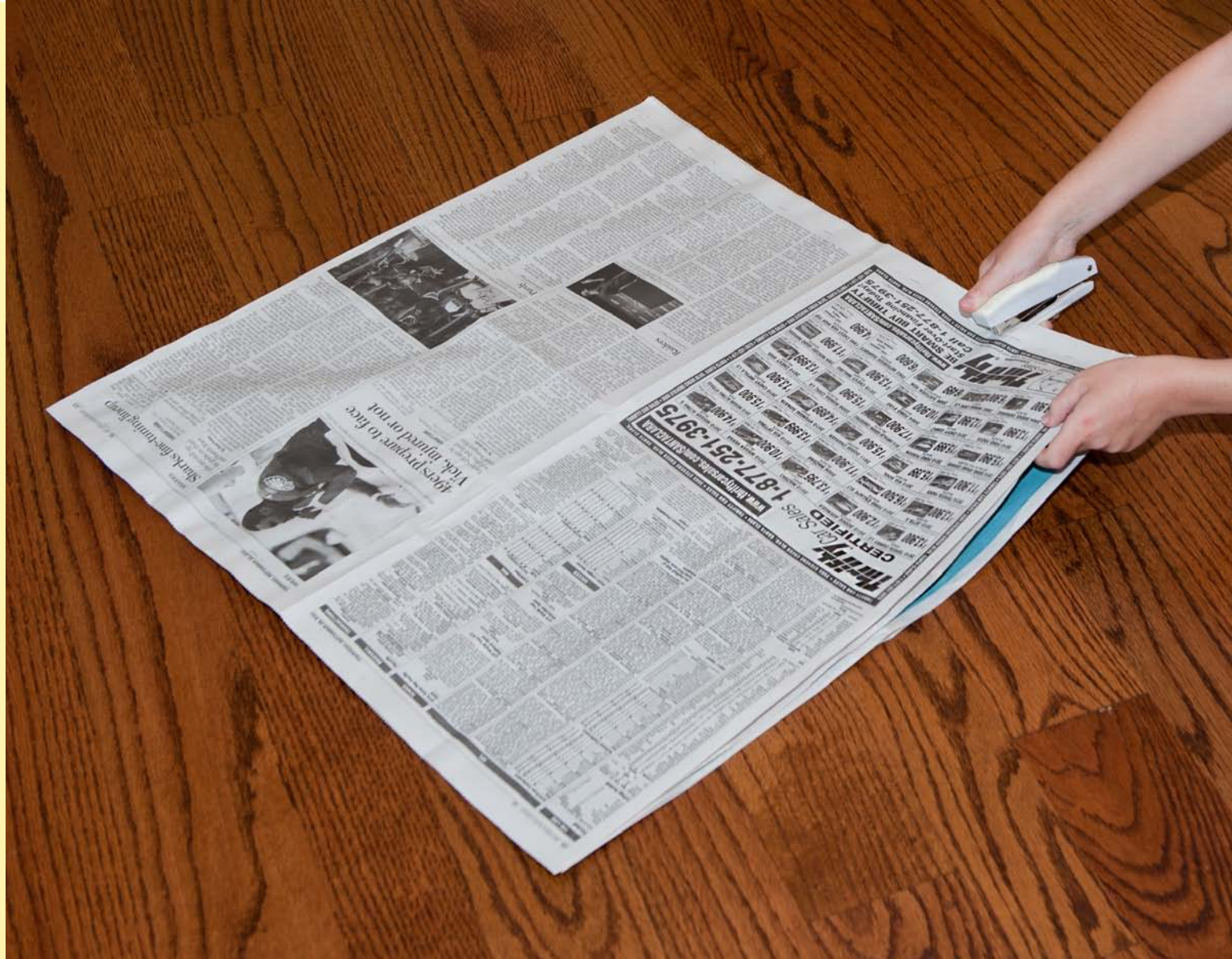




Owl





1. Staple 6 pages of newspaper together, leaving out one side for the opening at the bottom.



2. Fill it with anything that holds form (e.g. newspaper, bubble wrap) until you make it look like a pillow.



3. To make the bottom, take another 3 pages of newspaper.



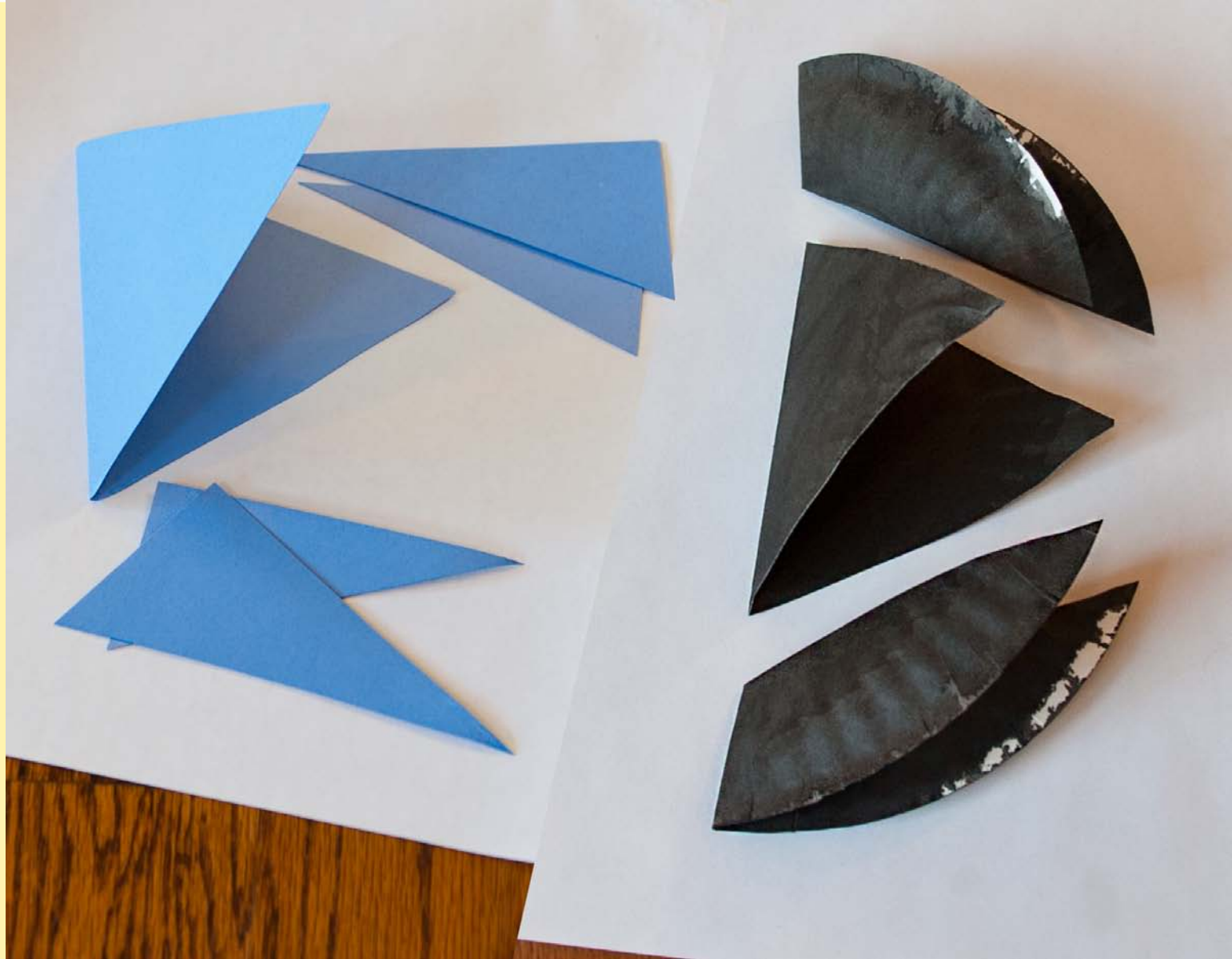
4. An adult can help attach the bottom by folding the edges around the sides and stapling like shown in this picture.



5. For the next step you will need gouache or tempera paint and two paper plates for the eyes.



6. Next, paint the eyes.



7. Then cut out the beak from a piece of colored paper or from another paper plate (make it large enough).



8. Then paint the owl; and be creative!



9. When the paint is dry, glue the eyes and beak.



10. Here is one more owl made by my older daughter. The beak can be different, don't hesitate to experiment.



11. We made white owls as Halloween decorations. They are made of white garbage bags on top of newspaper to protect them from rain.
