

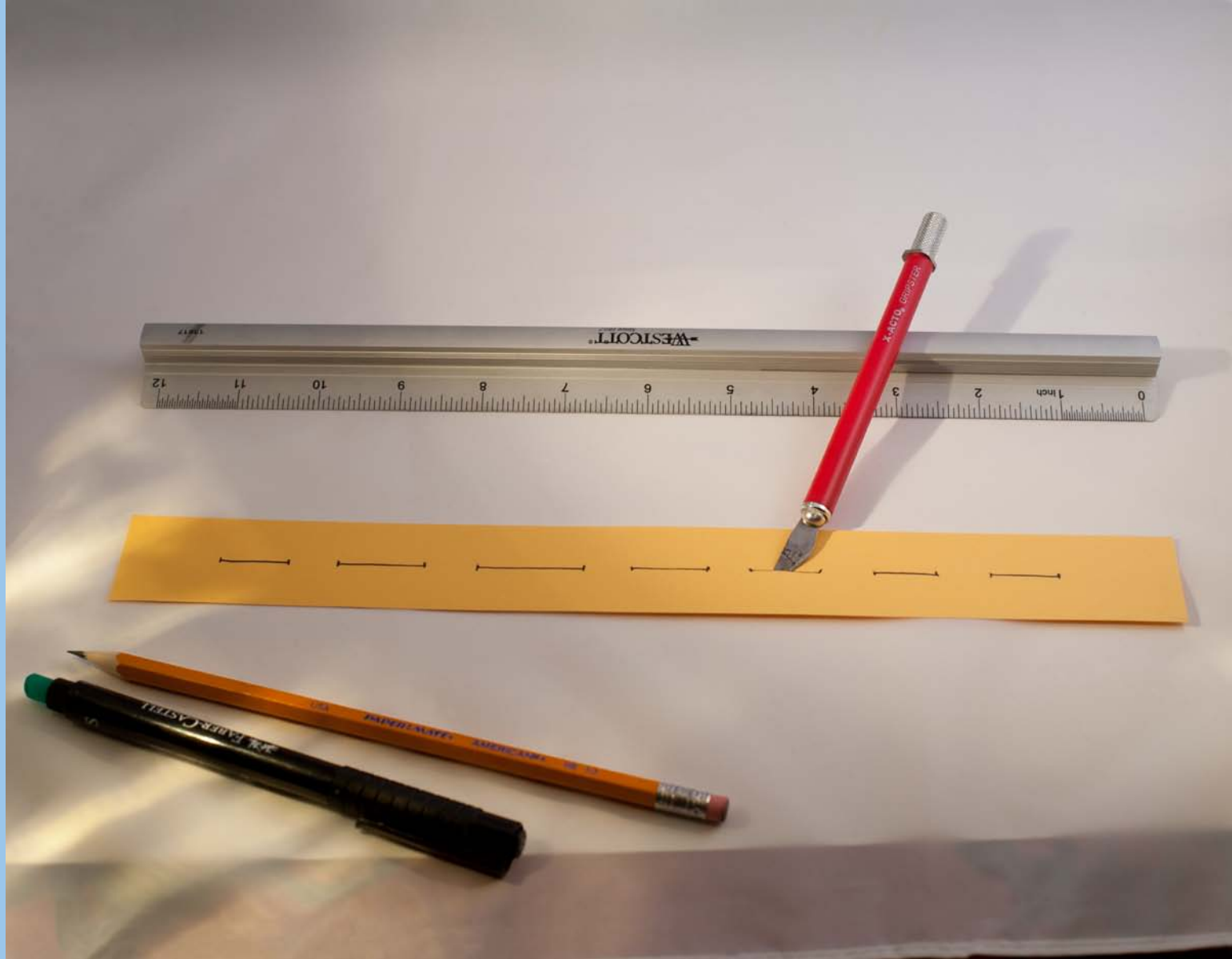


Wreath





1. First, take a walk around your neighborhood and collect all the colorful leaves, twigs, plants, and berries that you can find.



2. Now, you'll need a 12 inch strip of thick colored paper, in which you'll have to make about seven cuts along the middle.



3. Use a stapler to attach the ribbons. Make sure that you have cut them long enough to tie around your head.



4. Now slide plants and decorations in each of the cuts, and secure it with a stapler on both sides.



5. Once you cut off anything extra that's poking out from the bottom, your wreath is done.



6. Here's an example of how it looks on a person.



7. These are some wreaths that kids made some time ago. The ribbons were glued on, and the decorations were taped on. But staples works better: they hold everything securely and don't stick to hair.
